

## THE EMILIA BLANKET

### Skill level

Beginner friendly.

### Materials

Yarn: Knit at home - Chunky yarn. For this pattern I used a total of 6 skeins, a total of 1,2 kg.

Hook: A large wooden hook, 25 mm. You can of course finger crochet this blanket but it's quite heavy and also hard to get those even stitches.

And of course a scissor to cut the yarn with.

### Abbreviations, US terms (UK)

ch – chain stitch

ch sp - chain space

sc – single crochet (double crochet)

sk – skip stitch

st – stitch

\*...\* – repeat instructions the entire row

### Extra info

The finished blanket measures 65 cm/25,6" wide and 90 cm/35,4" long.

Please note:

- All sc, after row 2, is worked in the ch sp:s from the previous row.
- All rows end with a chain 2; which is the turning stitches.
- The last sc should always fall into the ch 2 turning stitch, please be sure to not miss it as doing so will result in a decrease.



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## Pattern

Chain 21 stitches loosely (or use an odd number of stitches to make it smaller or larger).

### Row 1:

Sc in the third stitch from your hook. \*Sc, ch 1, sk 1\*. Ch 2, turn.

### Row 2:

\*Sc, ch 1, sk 1\*. Ch 2, turn.

### Row 3-27:

Repeat row 2. Simple as that!

Now all that is left are the absolute final touches starting with cutting your yarn and ending with weaving in those ends on the blankets backside. That's it!
